Subject: Second Lower Feeder Relining Project

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan) has been working on a major water pipeline project in your community. Metropolitan is relining a portion of the Second Lower Feeder, a 78-inch diameter pipeline that is a critical component of the region's water system infrastructure. This project is necessary to ensure that we can continue to provide reliable water supplies to our 26 member public agencies serving 19 million people.

Construction began in November 2017 and will last to June 2018. Starting on January 13, 2018, the contractor will begin working on Saturdays from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm in order to keep on schedule. There has been much progress in the relining of the pipeline and a large portion of the work is inside of the pipe with an average of 40 workers welding and inspecting.

Metropolitan is grateful for your understanding and patience as every effort is being made to minimize this inconvenience by completing the work as quickly as possible.

The water supply to homes and businesses will not be affected.
