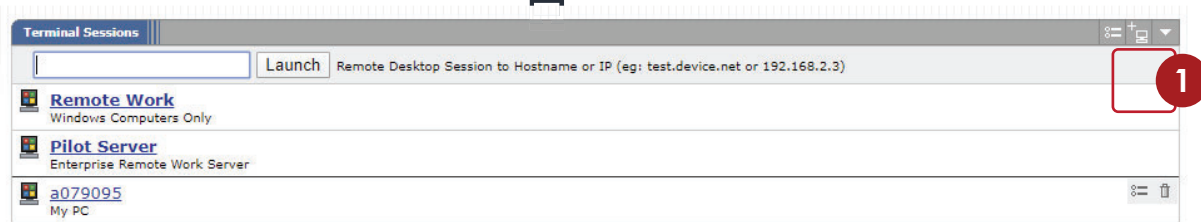

Add Existing Desktop to Terminal Session
