
To Members of the California Legislature:


The undersigned organizations urge a “NO” vote on AB 893, which was just amended to serve as the “consolidated” Delta bill, containing the provisions of all five bills which have been moving through the Legislature during the past six weeks. AB 893 contains many problems, has not been adequately vetted in public, and, if enacted, would invite litigation by many parties and undermine its very goals.


This measure, although well-intended, needs much more public review and amendment before it is ready for your consideration and approval. We pledge to work with the Legislature in the coming months on a strong package of Delta bills that would deserve your support.


Please vote “NO” on AB 893, today, the last day of the 2009 legislative session.


