JOB SUMMARY

Positions allocated to this class are entry level unskilled positions requiring no experience and are responsible for performing general maintenance duties relating to routine gardening and grounds maintenance, operational functions of District pumping and filtration plants and distribution systems, general labor and custodial, craft apprenticeship, and storekeeping.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS--Essential and other important responsibilities and duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Essential Functions:

- 1. Performs maintenance tasks associated with operations; learns and uses basic operations techniques required to effect changes in various facility operations.
- 2. Performs techniques of telephone and mobile radio communication; becomes familiar with alarm systems and basic emergency procedures relating to facility operations.
- 3. Digs ditches, paints, drives District vehicles, cleans plants and facilities, collects and disposes of trash, picks up and delivers freight, and runs miscellaneous errands.
- 4. Performs miscellaneous manual storekeeping tasks and assists storekeeping personnel in ordering, receiving, storing, issuing, and controlling supplies, tools, and equipment.
- 5. Operates a pickup truck, fork lift, or other light equipment as required.
- 6. Assists maintenance personnel and learns elementary skills for a particular craft under close supervision; becomes familiar with various types of mechanical apparatus used in maintenance activities.

- 7. Patrols, under direct supervision, the main aqueduct, distribution systems, or reservoir to inspect facilities, take readings, and operate system appurtenances.
- 8. Performs a variety of gardening tasks such as sowing, trimming, cultivating, weeding, watering, fertilizing, planting, pruning, and applying insecticides; operates garden tractors, mowers, sprayers, edgers, hedge trimmers, and other power equipment.
- 9. Performs other related duties as required.
