"Eggs-tra" Cool!

• Why does an egg float in salt water, but sink in plain tap water?

You will need:

- 2 eggs
- 2 tablespoons salt
- 2 drinking glasses

Get Started:

- Fill glasses with water.
- Put 2 tablespoons of salt into one glass and stir until dissolved.
- Put 1 egg in the salt water and the other egg in the plain water.
- What happened?
- Why?

Science Connection: buoyancy/density

Salt water is thicker, or more <u>dense</u>, than fresh water. When an object weighs less that the water beneath it, the object floats. The egg floats in the salt water because it weighs less than the water.
