

Urgent Infrastructure Maintenance in Your Community

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California is conducting an urgent repair to the Santa Monica Feeder, a key pipeline in our regional water delivery system. These improvements will ensure we continue to provide reliable water supplies to our 26 member agencies that serve 19 million customers in Southern California.


The Santa Monica Feeder extends 24 miles to distribute water to the cities of Glendale, Burbank, Los Angeles, Beverly Hills and Santa Monica. A significant leak has been detected in the pipeline and requires immediate attention. Work will include excavation for external inspection and repair.

SCHEDULE

The activities are scheduled to begin at 4 a.m. on April 9 and continue for several days until the work is complete.

PROJECT LOCATION

The work will occur on N. Santa Monica Blvd. in Beverly Hills between Moreno Drive and Wilshire Blvd.



WHAT TO EXPECT


You may notice the following:

The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California is a state-established cooperative of 26 member agencies—cities and public water agencies—that serve about 19 million people in six counties. Metropolitan imports water from the Colorado River and Northern California to supplement local supplies, and helps its members to develop increased water conservation, recycling, storage, and other resource-management programs.
